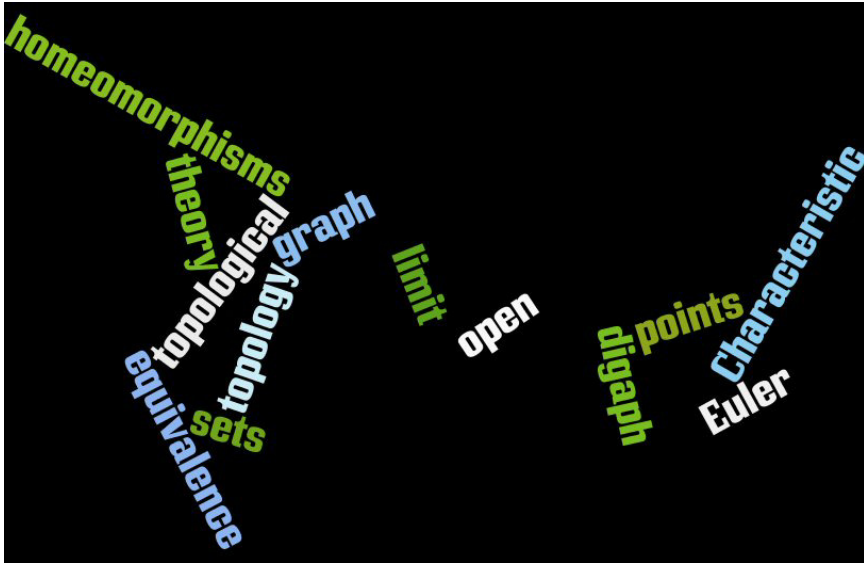


Leonhard Euler (1707-1783)
